**Safety procedures**

- Avoid contact.**
- Avoid touching your face.**
- Wear a mask.**
- Wear gloves.**
- Practise Shipboard Self-Distancing (SSD).**

According to IMO Circular Letter No.4204 and the ICS Guidance for Ship Operators for the Protection of the Health of Seafarers

SC 001

**Safety procedures**

- Wash or disinfect your hands regularly.**
- Practise Shipboard Self-Distancing (SSD)**
- Cough or sneeze into your elbow or tissue.**
- Avoid contact.**
- Avoid touching your face.**
- Stay in your cabin if you are unwell. Inform the Master. DO NOT go ashore.**

SC 002

**Hand and respiratory hygiene precautions**

- Passengers and crew must wash hands frequently using soap and hot water or alcohol-based (at least 65-70%). Rub hands thoroughly for at least 20 seconds.**
- Avoid touching your face, including mouth, nose and eyes with unwashed hands.**
- Cover nose and mouth with a disposable tissue when sneezing, coughing, wiping and blowing the nose. Immediately dispose of the used tissue.**
- If you don't have a tissue, cover nose and mouth and cough or sneeze into a flexed elbow.**
- Keep at least 1 metre (3 feet) distance from other people.**

SC 003

**COVID-19 Protect yourself and others from getting sick**

- When coughing and sneezing, cover your nose and mouth with a tissue or a flexed elbow.**
- Throw the tissue into a closed bin immediately after use.**
- Clean your hands with an alcohol-based hand rub or with soap and hot water for at least 20 seconds:**
  - After coughing or sneezing
  - When caring for the sick
  - Before, during and after preparing food
  - Before eating
  - After toilet use
  - When hands are visibly dirty.
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth.**

SC 004

**Safety procedures for Ship and shore-based personnel interface**

**If attendance onboard a ship is unavoidable:**

- Minimize the number of persons attending.**
- Use outer walkways. Avoid access through the crew accommodation.**
- Reduce time inside crew accommodation to the absolute minimum necessary to perform duties onboard.**
- Do not shake hands. Use a wave, a nod or a bow.**
- Maintain social distancing.**
- Frequently clean your hands with soap and hot water for at least 20 seconds or use an alcohol-based hand rub.**
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth.**
- Make sure your face mask covers your mouth and nose.**
- Do not touch the face mask once it is on.**
- Immediately safely discard single-use masks after each use.**
- Clean your hands after removing masks.**

According to IMO Circular Letter No.4204 and the ICS Guidance for Ship Operators for the Protection of the Health of Seafarers

SC 005

**Stay healthy while travelling**

- Eat only well cooked food.**
- Avoid spitting in public.**
- Avoid close contact and travel with sick animals, particularly in wet markets.**
- Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth.**
- Frequently clean your hands with an alcohol-based hand rub or with soap and hot water for at least 20 seconds.**
- Avoid close contact with people suffering from a fever or a cough.**
- When coughing and sneezing, cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or flexed elbow. Throw the tissue into a closed bin immediately after use and clean your hands.**
- If wearing a face mask, be sure it covers your mouth and nose and do not touch it once on. Immediately discard single-use masks after each use and clean your hands after removing masks.**
- If you become sick while travelling, tell crew or ground staff.**
- Seek medical care early if you become sick, and share your history with your health provider.**

SC 006

**How to Handwash?**

**Clean hands protect against infection**

Duration of the entire procedure: 40-60 seconds

- Wet hands with water.**
- Apply enough soap to cover all hand surfaces.**
- Rub palms palm to palm.**
- Right palm over left wrist with interlaced fingers and rotate wrist.**
- Finger to palm with fingers interlaced.**
- Backs of right hand to opposing palm with fingers interlaced.**
- Rotate wrist with water. Rub hands with water. Rotate wrist with water.**
- Rinse hands with water. Use lower to turn off faucet.**
- Use towel to dry hands. Your hands are now safe.**

SC 007

**Hand sanitization**

**Begin by removing all rings, bracelets and watches**

- 1. Apply disinfectant or soap and water and rub your hands for the duration of time to cover all visible surfaces.**
- 2. Rub your palms together.**
- 3. Rub with fingers interlaced.**
- 4. Rub the back of your fingers against your palm.**
- 5. Rub your thumbs using your other hand. Repeat with the other thumb.**
- 6. Rub the side of your fingers on the palm of your other hand in a circular motion.**
- 7. Rub each wrist with opposite hand.**
- 8. Once dry, your hands should be clean & safe.**

**How to use the hygiene mask**

- Wash your hands well before putting on the mask.**
- Cover your mouth, nose and chin completely.**
- Replace the mask as soon as it is wet and dispose in the nearest rubbish bin.**
- Wash your hands well after discarding the mask.**

### MATERIALS – VERTICAL INSTALLATION SIGNAGE

- **Photoluminescent rigid plastic (F)**  
1.2mm thick photoluminescent rigid plastic, antistatic surface and easy to clean.
- **Self-adhesive photoluminescent vinyl (Z)**  
0.39mm thick self-adhesive photoluminescent vinyl, antistatic surface and easy to clean.
- **White rigid plastic (O)**  
1mm thick white photoluminescent rigid plastic, antistatic surface and easy to clean.
- **White self-adhesive vinyl (V)**  
0.061mm thick white self-adhesive vinyl, antistatic surface and easy to clean.
- **2mm thick composite aluminium (T)**  
Material composed of two 0.25mm thick aluminium layers and a polyethylene interior. Light, resistant and with anti-static surface.

### MATERIALS – HORIZONTAL INSTALLATION SIGNAGE

- **Non-slip vinyl for floor (VP)**  
Material composed of a self-adhesive PVC film, 0,08mm thick, coated with a transparent non-slip protection film, in monomeric calandered PVC. The total thickness of the product after application is 0,3mm.

Slip resistance is characterized by the coefficient of static and dynamic friction:

Dynamic friction coefficient (ANSI A 137.1:2012)	
Humid	0,236
Static friction coefficient (ANSI B 101.1:2009)	
Humid	0,452

- **Opaque vinyl for floor (VB)**  
Self-adhesive PVC film signage, for temporary use, 0,08mm thick and with anti-static surface.
